MEMORY VERSE

Ahab son of Omri did what was evil in the Lord's sight more than all who were before him. *1 Kings 16: 30*

Ahab: "did more to anger the Lord God of Israel than all the kings of Israel that who were before him." He was not a good king! He made alters to other God's because he saw the nations around him doing it. He wanted to be a king like he saw around him. He took his eye off the Lord and forgot who was his great example.

Elijah: God's prophet, and the one who knew the power of God would overcome the false God Baal. He challenges the prophets of Baal on Mount Carmel and sees God move in power.
